RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE DECLARATION OF OFFICIAL INTENT UNDER TREASURY REGULATION SECTION 1.150-2 TO REIMBURSE PRIOR EXPENDITURES RELATED TO VARIOUS SEWER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority (the "Authority") intends to issue debt obligations, the interest on which is excluded from gross income under Section 103 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code") and that will be used to finance various sewer improvements, including modifications to sanitary sewer pipe allotment and additional construction at the Franklin Lakes pump station, as part of the Franklin Lakes Business District Sanitary Sewer Project (the debt obligations herein referred to as "Project Debt Obligations" herein referred to as the "Project");

WHEREAS, the Authority intends to finance the Project, in part, with the Project Debt Obligations but may pay for certain costs of the Project ("Project Costs") prior to the issuance of the Project Debt Obligations with funds of the Authority which are not borrowed funds;

WHEREAS, the Authority desires to preserve its rights to treat an allocation of proceeds of the Project Debt Obligations to the reimbursement of Project Costs paid by the Authority prior to the issuance of the Project Debt Obligations as an expenditure for such Project Costs to be reimbursed for purposes of Sections 103 and 141-150 of the Code.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the Authority as follows:

- **Section 1.** The Authority reasonably expects to reimburse its expenditure of Project Costs paid prior to the issuance of the Project Debt Obligations with proceeds of its Project Debt Obligations.
- **Section 2.** This resolution is intended to be and hereby is a declaration of the Authority's official intent to reimburse the Authority for expenditure of Project Costs by the Authority paid prior to the issuance of the Project Debt Obligations with the proceeds of the Project Debt Obligations, in accordance with Treasury Regulation Section 150-2.
- **Section 3.** The maximum principal amount of the Project Debt Obligations expected to be issued to finance the Project is \$600,000.
- **Section 4.** The Project Costs to be reimbursed with the proceeds of the Project Debt Obligations will be "capital expenditures" in accordance with the meaning of Section 150 of the Code.

WHEREAS, the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority intends to file a loan application with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Trust for the Authority's Incinerator Improvements:

The proposed project includes various upgrades and improvements to the Authority's two (2) existing incinerators. Proposed work includes upgrades to the existing Niro and IDI incinerator units to meet upcoming EPA air emission limits (40CFR60 Subpart-MMMM). These improvements consist of retro-fitting both units with caustic addition to the wet scrubbers to improve SO₂ removal efficiency, and the addition of fixed bed sulfur impregnated activated carbon adsorbers (and associated ancillary systems) to remove mercury from the exhaust. Major ductwork modifications and valve installations will also be required to complete the proposed work, as well as, a new platform to house the equipment. Other improvements include replacement in kind of the corroded ductwork and plenums on the IDI incinerator.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Howard Hurwitz, Executive Director, be authorized to act as the Authorized Representative to represent the Authority in all matters relating to the project undertaken pursuant to the above referenced New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Loan to be executed with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Trust.
