WHEREAS, by Resolution 18-2015, the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority (the "Authority") identified a number of firms as qualified to perform consulting engineer services for the 2016 Service Charges required by the Authority pursuant to a Request for Qualifications for such position, which notice thereof was published on January 16, 2015; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 23-2015 (the "Original Resolution") the Authority retained the firm of Tighe & Bond as Consulting Engineer for the 2016 Service Charges to the Authority and authorized the Chairman to execute a Professional Services Agreement between the Authority and T&M; and

WHEREAS, a Professional Services Agreement dated March 2, 2015 between the Authority and T&M was executed by the parties thereafter; and

WHEREAS, the Original Resolution and the Professional Services Agreement provides for Consulting Engineer's compensation to be capped at \$33,000 and that in the event that it anticipates it will exceed that amount, to seek further authorization from the Authority at such time; and

WHEREAS, Tighe & Bond has advised the Authority that due to 1) Advise with the replacement of failing meters 2) Assistance in determining the Water Use and Equivalent dwelling units in the Borough of Ramsey and Township of Mahwah which included attendance at multiple meetings 3) consulting services to obtain correlations between the data from the local meters, Mission Controls and Authority for meters at the Midland Park Pump Station and the Darlington Pump Station that engineering fees for such services will cause the overall compensation to Tighe & Bond to exceed \$33,000; and

WHEREAS, T&M has requested the Authority increase the not to exceed cost for consulting engineer services provided by their firm to \$39,500.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority hereby amends the Original Resolution and the Professional Services Agreement with Tighe & Bond to increase the not to exceed amount to \$39,500 due to the reasons outlined above in Paragraph 5 but subject to the rates and all other terms and conditions of the Original Resolution & Professional Services Agreement; and be it

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ENERGY GENERATION SERVICES FOR PUBLIC USE ON AN ONLINE AUCTION WEBSITE

WHEREAS, the annual budget for electricity use by the Authority is approximately \$1.3 million; and

WHEREAS, the Local Unit Electronic Technology Pilot Program and Study Act (P.L. 201c30) provides an exception to New Jersey's Public Bid Law allowing the Authority to forego traditional RFQs when purchasing electricity and to purchase electricity through an online reverse auction process in order to reduce cost; and

WHEREAS, The NJ Department of Community Affairs has approved EMEX, LLC of Houston, TX as a vendor to offer its reverse auction platform to NJ local contracting units for the purchase of energy generation services; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has previously participated in such auctions and has been purchasing electric power at a fixed price for the past 24 months; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has experienced significant savings during this period, and

WHEREAS, the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority again plans to utilize the online auction services of EMEX, LLC, an approved vendor pursuant to the Act, waiver number EMEX LLC-1, located at www.energymarketexchange.com; and

WHEREAS, the auction will be conducted pursuant to the Act.

RESOLVED, by the Commissioners of the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority that the staff is authorized to participate in an online reverse auction for the purpose of purchasing electricity from third party suppliers for use by the Authority; and
