PROPOSED SANITARY SEWER EXTENSION – BOROUGH OF ALLENDALE, 265 WEST CRESCENT AVE. BLOCK 910, LOTS 2, 17.01 & 17.02

RESOLVED,

WHEREAS, an application has been made to the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority (hereinafter sometimes referred to as the "Authority"), by Calvary Lutheran Church of Allendale (hereinafter referred to as the "Applicant"), for approval of one proposed sanitary sewer connection/extension to serve three (3) new single family dwellings. The sewer extension is located off Ivers Road off West Crescent Avenue adjacent to Calvary Lutheran Church. The proposed extension will connect to the existing sanitary sewer located in Ivers Road. The proposed extension requires the installation of approximately 294 linear feet of 8 inch PVC sewer, two manholes and appurtenances; and

WHEREAS, the Authority technical advisor has reviewed the application and the documents and drawings submitted in support thereof and, by memorandum dated June 14, 2012, has recommended that the Authority approve the Project, subject to fulfillment of certain terms and conditions, finding that when completed, the Project will contribute an average daily flow of 900 gallons per day (gpd) from which three (3) additional residential EDUs will become tributary to the Authority's system from the Borough of Allendale; and
