1. Complete a brief statement on the 2013 proposed Annual Budget and make comparison to the current year's adopted budget. Explain significant increases or decreases, if any.

The Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority's proposed 2013 annual budget totals \$17,203,490. The budget includes a one-time transfer of funds from restricted debt service reserves in the amount of \$2,962,535. These funds will be used to fund capital projects (\$850,000) and to support a 2% reduction in annual charges to members (\$274,571). In addition, \$1,598,983 will be reserved to stabilize future municipal service charges. The balance will be utilized to offset decreases from other revenue sources. The 2013 proposed budget for Operating, Debt Service and Capital Projects of \$15,604,507 is \$66,607 less than the \$15,671,114 budget adopted for 2012.

2. Complete a brief statement on the impact the proposed Annual Budget will have on Anticipated Revenues, especially service charges and on the general purpose/component unit financial statements. Explain significant increases or decreases, if any.

The proposed 2013 budget will provide sufficient revenues to fund operations for the year ending December 31, 2013. As described above, service charges to member municipalities will be reduced by 2% in 2013 when compared with the previous year.

3. Describe the state of the local/regional economy and how it may impact the proposed Annual Budget, including the planned Capital Budget/Program.

There will be minimal impact on the local economy as a result of the Annual Operating and Capital Budget presented herein. The reduced member municipal charges will have a positive impact.

4. Describe the reasons for utilizing Unrestricted Net Assets in the proposed Annual Budget, i.e. rate stabilization, debt service reduction, to balance the budget, etc.

As described above, \$274,571 of available Debt Service Reserves was utilized in the proposed Annual Budget to reduce the amount required from service agreement revenue by 2% from 2012.
