

4.15 Categorical Pretreatment Standards & Authority Local Limits for Metals:

All existing and new industrial users shall comply with the Authority's Local Limits and all applicable Categorical Pretreatment Standards as listed in 40 CFR 403.6 and 40 CFR Chapter I, subchapter N.

New Dischargers will be required to demonstrate, to the satisfaction of the Authority, that their proposed discharge meets all applicable pretreatment standards and local limitations prior to receiving authorization (permit) to discharge.

Existing dischargers will be given an interim compliance period, to be determined by the Authority and in compliance with 40 CFR Chapter I, Subchapter N. The compliance period shall not be longer than three years.

The issuance of all standards and limitations to industrial users; compliance monitoring; and compliance determinations shall be handled by the Authority's Industrial Pretreatment Program as delegated to them by the State of New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection.

Any user determined to be out of compliance with any pretreatment standard and/or local limit shall be determined to be in violation of the Authority's Rules and Regulations and will be subject to the Authority's Enforcement Policy and Enforcement Response plan as listed in Article IX & X, respectively.

Listed below is the Northwest Bergen County Local Limits for Metals:
